The Gallery at Fifth Third Center

Display Wall

The gallery has space for paintings, photography, drawings, sculptures, small ceramics, pottery and jewelry works. Wall space is provided with hangers for paintings, drawings and photography. Cases are provided for ceramics, pottery and jewelry.

The first floor gallery main wall measures 28'10" long x 11'3" tall. The wall is made of elegant polished granite in gray and burgundy coloring. Three side walls are also polished granite and measure 13'6" long x 11' 3" tall. Two 4' column spaces are also available for display.

In addition to the gallery space in the lobby there are two additional walls on the second floor to display paintings, photography and drawings. One wall measures 11' long x 8'11" tall and one wall measures 13' long x 8'11" tall.

Cases

There are two polished brass display cases with glass on three sides and two adjustable glass shelves. Each case is on wheels and sets on a base of cherry wood. Both cases measure 5' x 5' x 1 ½'.

Artist's Responsibilities

The artist is responsible for placing works in the gallery including hanging, case design and placement of artwork labels. The artist should provide a bio that includes contact information to the Gallery Coordinator at least one month prior to their exhibit. Price sheets can be turned in once the exhibit is displayed.

Artists are required to carry their own insurance and execute our standard Waiver and Indemnification Agreement.

The artist is also responsible for any outside advertising beyond the Fifth Third Center Tower and announcements provided on the building's website at www.1southmaindayton.com. It is recommended that the artist contact the Dayton Daily News and other local media to advertise their exhibit.

Gallery Hours of Operation

Fifth Third Center is located at the corner of Third and Main Streets, Dayton, Ohio and is open to the public from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and closed Sundays.

Receptions:

Artists are encouraged to host a reception in The Gallery at Fifth Third Center during their exhibition month. Receptions may be held Monday through Friday and should be scheduled with the Gallery Coordinator at least one month in advance. Available upon request are:

- Tables (covered and skirted)
- Chairs
- Electrical outlets
- Trash Containers

Parking:

Covered parking is available in the Fifth Third Center parking garage located on Ludlow Street. Parking will be validated for the artists and their guests. A loading dock, located off Main Street, between Third and Fourth Streets is available for loading and unloading exhibits.

Additional Information:

- Exhibits should be setup within the first three business days of each month and taken down by the last business day of each month.
- Scotch tape is the only substance to be used in displaying name tags
- Carts for loading and unloading are available from the Gallery Coordinator or at the Security desk
- There are no fees or commissions for exhibiting
- Wall exhibits will be hung by building staff
- Display cases will be opened and closed by building staff
- No form of artistic nudity is permitted
- Inquiries for purchases will be directed to the artist
